<p><b>4.</b> Psalm 71:1-6 <b>Hymn of the Week:</b> <i>A Mighty Fortress is our God</i> (200) <b>Thought to Consider:</b> God's promises are a sure fortress.</p>		<p><b>5.</b> Psalm 46 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Believers of all times have found strength in this psalm. Read or sing hymn 200 v. 1.</p>		<p><b>6.</b> Jer 16:19-21 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> The prophet Jeremiah found strength and security in the Lord when he faced distress. Read our sing hymn 200 v. 2.</p>		<p><b>7.</b> 1 Pe 5:8-11 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Satan prowls to snatch us from the Lord. We find strength in God's promises. Read or sing hymn 200 v. 3.</p>		<p><b>8.</b> Ma 4:1-11 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus thwarted Satan's temptations by using God's Word—a good example for us. Read or sing hymn 200 v. 4.</p>		<p><b>9.</b> Psalm 18:30-36 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> God arms us against those who threaten our faith. He is our Rock. Read or sing hymn 200 v. 2.</p>		<p><b>10.</b> Psalm 62:5-8 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> At all times we can turn to the Lord for help. He is our refuge. Read or sing hymn 200 v. 1.</p>					
<p><b>11.</b> Psalm 73:21-28 <b>Hymn of the Week:</b> <i>My Hope is Built on Nothing Less</i> (382) <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus, only Jesus.</p>		<p><b>12.</b> Ma 7:24-29 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We build on the solid rock and nothing else. Only the rock of Jesus' words is sure. Read or sing hymn 382 v. 1.</p>		<p><b>13.</b> Psalm 130 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Often we face the depths but our hope rests on the Lord's faithful love. Read or sing hymn 382 v. 2.</p>		<p><b>14.</b> Ro 5:1-11 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Because we are justified by grace through faith, we can endure all life's troubles. Read or sing hymn 382 v. 3.</p>		<p><b>15.</b> Psalm 42 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> When we are downcast, we turn to the Lord, our Savior and our God. Read or sing hymn 382 v. 2.</p>		<p><b>16.</b> 1 Co 15:12-19 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> The resurrection of Jesus from the dead is the foundation of our faith. Read or sing hymn 382 v. 1.</p>		<p><b>17.</b> Jn 6:66-68 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> No one else can give us eternal life. We look for all God's blessings in Jesus. Read or sing hymn 382 v. 4.</p>					
<p><b>18.</b> Psalm 96 <b>Hymn of the Week:</b> <i>Praise to God Immortal Praise</i> (612) <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We praise God for his steadfast love for us.</p>		<p><b>19.</b> Eph 1:3-10 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Think of all the reasons we have to praise God. He has lavished so many blessings on us. Read or sing hymn 612 v. 1.</p>		<p><b>20.</b> Psalm 104 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> This longer psalm praises God for all the blessings of life here. Read or sing hymn 612 v. 2.</p>		<p><b>21.</b> Lk 1:67-79 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Note the blessings Zechariah counts as he praised God when his son John was born. Read or sing hymn 612 v. 3.</p>		<p><b>22.</b> Psalm 146 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Count the blessings God has given to you in your lifetime. Read or sing hymn 612 v. 3.</p>		<p><b>23.</b> Psalm 116:10-19 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We bring our offerings to the Lord, grateful for his blessings. Read or sing hymn 612 v. 4.</p>		<p><b>24.</b> 2 Co 1:2-7 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> God comforts us in all our troubles so we can share that comfort with others in trouble. Read or sing hymn 612 v. 1.</p>					
<p><b>25.</b> Psalm 99 <b>Hymn of the Week:</b> <i>Crown Him with Many Crowns</i> (341) <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus, our great King rules forever.</p>		<p><b>26.</b> Rev 19:11-16 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> King of kings and Lord of lords, Jesus will reign forever. Read or sing hymn 341 v. 1.</p>		<p><b>27.</b> Ma 27:27-31 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Wearing a crown of thorns he is our King and has redeemed us with his blood. Read or sing hymn 341 v. 2.</p>		<p><b>28.</b> 1 Pe 1:3-6 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> His resurrection has secured our victory over the grave. Read or sing hymn 341 v. 3.</p>		<p><b>29.</b> Rev 5:9-14 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Praise to our king who sits on the throne of heaven and rules all things for our good. Read or sing hymn 341 v. 4.</p>		<p><b>30.</b> Php 2:5-11 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> He humbled himself to save us, and we kneel to honor him. Read or sing hymn 342 v. 1.</p>		<p><b>1.</b> Psalm 95 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We bow in worship and praise for he is our Rock of salvation. Read or sing hymn 341 v. 4.</p>
