Read or sing hymn 103 v. 2.</p>	<p><b>3.</b> Heb 10:11-14 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus is the one perfect sacrifice for all sin. Glory be to Jesus! Read or sing hymn 103 v. 3.</p>	<p><b>4.</b> Heb 12:22-24 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We have heaven, the new Jerusalem, waiting for us because Jesus shed his blood for us. Read or sing hymn 103 v. 3.</p>	<p><b>5.</b> Heb 13:15-16 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We know life here is not perfect, but Jesus has opened the door to our perfect life in heaven. Read or sing hymn 103 v. 5.</p>	<p><b>6.</b> Ro 3:21-26 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Praise Jesus! We are justified freely by God's grace. Read or sing hymn 103 v. 6.</p>
<p><b>7.</b> Is 53:1-3 <b>Hymn of the Week</b> <i>O Sacred Head, Now Wounded</i> (105) <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus was crucified for all unworthy sinners.</p>	<p><b>8.</b> Jn 19:1-6 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> By faith we behold Jesus who was beaten for us. Read or sing hymn 105 v. 1.</p>	<p><b>9.</b> Mt 27:27-31 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Our beautiful Savior is mocked so we could be redeemed and forgiven. Read or sing hymn 105 v. 2.</p>	<p><b>10.</b> Ps 22:1-19 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> This Psalm reminds us that Christ's crucifixion was always God's plan. Read or sing hymn 105 v. 3.</p>	<p><b>11.</b> Is 53:4-9 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Our sins are the cause of the suffering and death of Jesus. He suffered for us. Read or sing hymn 105 v. 4.</p>	<p><b>12.</b> Is 12:1-6 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We praise and thank Jesus for claiming us from the slavery of sin. Read or sing hymn 105 v. 5.</p>	<p><b>13.</b> Lk 23:35-43 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Paradise is our gift because of Jesus. Read or sing hymn 105 v. 6.</p>
<p><b>14.</b> Mt 21:1-11 <b>Hymn of the Week:</b> <i>Go to Dark Gethsemane</i> (104) <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus enters Jerusalem. Hosanna to the Son of David!</p>	<p><b>15.</b> Mt 26:36-46 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus prayed in agony while his disciples slept. Let us watch and pray. Read or sing hymn 104 v. 1.</p>	<p><b>16.</b> Jn 18:28-40 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Pilate finds Jesus innocent. The crowd chooses a criminal in place of Jesus. Read or sing hymn 104 v. 2.</p>	<p><b>17.</b> Mk 15:21-32 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We follow Jesus to his crucifixion for us. Read or sing hymn 104 v. 3.</p>	<p><b>18.</b> Mt 26:17-39 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus gives us his body and blood in his Supper. For Maundy Thursday read or sing hymn 310 v. 1.</p>	<p><b>19.</b> Jn 19:28-37 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus died and was buried to secure our redemption. Read or sing hymn 104 v. 3.</p>	<p><b>20.</b> Jn 19:38-42 <b>Thoughts to Consider:</b> His burial was temporary. He would overcome death. Read or sing hymn 104 v. 4.</p>
<p><b>21.</b> Mt 28:1-10 <b>Hymn of the Week:</b> <i>I Know that My Redeemer Lives</i> (152) <b>Thought to Consider:</b> He is risen! He is risen indeed!</p>	<p><b>22.</b> Mk 16:1-8 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> The women discover Jesus is not in the tomb but alive. Read or sing hymn 152 v. 1.</p>	<p><b>23.</b> Jn 20:11-18 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus appears to Mary to prove he is alive and no longer dead. Read or sing hymn 152 v. 2.</p>	<p><b>24.</b> Jn 20:19-23 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus appears to his disciples and brings peace and hope. Read or sing hymn 153 v. 3.</p>	<p><b>25.</b> 1 Co 15:12-20 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> If Jesus did not rise, our faith is worthless. Read or sing hymn 152 v. 4.</p>	<p><b>26.</b> 1 Co 15:1-11 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus rose. So many witnesses saw him and confirm his resurrection from the dead. Read or sing hymn 152 v. 5.</p>	<p><b>27.</b> 1 Co 15:42-48 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We will be raised with glorified bodies to live with him. Read or sing hymn 152 v. 8.</p>
