11. Heb 3:12-15 Why am I here? Remain faithful to the Lord to the end. Encourage others to remain faithful to the Lord.

12. Heb 4:14-16 Why am I here? Hold firmly to the faith and make sure to take all your concerns to the Lord in prayer. He can sympathize

with us.

13. Heb 6:10-12 Why am I here? So often our good Christian life is not noticed. But God will not forget your efforts.
