Read or sing hymn 381 v. 5.</p>
<p><b>3.</b> Mt 11:28-30 <b>Hymn of the Week:</b> <i>Blessed Jesus at Your Word</i> (221) <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We gather to hear the words of Jesus love.</p>	<p><b>4.</b> Psalm 122 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> So often we hear encouragement to come into the house of the Lord. Read or sing hymn 221 v. 1.</p>	<p><b>5.</b> Heb 10:22-25 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> In life's joys and troubles, we come to worship together and praise God. Read or sing hymn 221 v. 2.</p>	<p><b>6.</b> 1Co 2:10-16 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> The Holy Spirit has opened our minds to see and understand all God has given us. Read or sing hymn 221 v. 2.</p>	<p><b>7.</b> Jn 8:1-20 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Without Jesus we walk in darkness. He is the light of the world. Read or sing hymn 221 v. 3.</p>	<p><b>8.</b> Psalm 138 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Praise comes from our hearts and lips because of God's love. Read or sing hymn 221 v. 4.</p>	<p><b>9.</b> Eph 1:3-10 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Consider how many reasons you have to praise your Savior. Read or sing hymn 221 v. 4.</p>	
<p><b>10.</b> Mal 4:1-2 <b>Hymn of the Week:</b> <i>Jerusalem the Golden</i> (214) <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Watch. The Lord is coming again.</p>	<p><b>11.</b> Rev 21:1-4 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> God promises us eternal life and freedom from all earthly troubles through Christ. Read or sing hymn 214 v. 1.</p>	<p><b>12.</b> Mt 25:31-46 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus will come again and will welcome those who believe in him to heaven. Read or sing hymn 214 v. 2.</p>	<p><b>13.</b> Jn 5:19-24 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> When Jesus comes to judge the world, he will welcome all believers. They will enter life. Read or sing hymn 214 v. 2.</p>	<p><b>14.</b> Lk 19:11-27 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> When Jesus comes to judge, he will say "Well done, good servant" to believers, Read or sing hymn 214 v. 3.</p>	<p><b>15.</b> Heb 13:14-16 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We wait for the city God has prepared for us—the new Jerusalem. Read or sing hymn 214 v. 4.</p>	<p><b>16.</b> 1Th 5:1-11 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We wait in hope for the Lord's return—a hope based on his gracious promises. Read or sing hymn 214 v. 1.</p>	
<p><b>17.</b> Rev 3:21-22 <b>Hymn of the Week:</b> <i>For All the Saints</i> (551) <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We shall rest from our labors and be with the Lord.</p>	<p><b>18.</b> Isa 52:1-6 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We sing for joy because the Lord has purchased us with the blood of Jesus to be his own people. Read or sing hymn 551 v. 1.</p>	<p><b>19.</b> Psalm 84 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We yearn for the glory, peace, and joy that Jesus promises to his believers. Read or sing hymn 551 v. 2.</p>	<p><b>20.</b> 1Th 4:13-18 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We continue to struggle here, but we wait for the Lord's return and our resurrection. Read or sing hymn 551 v. 4.</p>	<p><b>21.</b> 1Ti 6:11-16 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We struggle but we shall inherit eternal life through Christ. Read or sing hymn 551 v. 5.</p>	<p><b>22.</b> Psalm 121 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> We cling to God's promises as we look for our deliverance. Read or sing hymn 551 v. 7.</p>	<p><b>23.</b> Rev. 7:9-17 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> The host of heaven praise God for the salvation he has provided by grace. Read or sing hymn 551 v. 8.</p>	
<p><b>24.</b> Rev 1:12-18 <b>Hymn of the Week:</b> <i>Hail, O Once-despised Jesus</i> (351) <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Jesus reigns above all and watches over his saints.</p>	<p><b>25.</b> Mt 27:27-31 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Soldiers mocked him, but we revere him as our King. Read or sing hymn 351 v. 1.</p>	<p><b>26.</b> Col 1:15-22 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Through Jesus sinners are reconciled to God by making peace through his blood. Read or sing hymn 351 v. 2.</p>	<p><b>27.</b> Isa 53:4-10 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> God has laid all our sins on our King, Jesus, so we might have eternal life. Read or sing hymn 351 v. 2.</p>	<p><b>28.</b> Psalm 45 <b>THANKSGIVING Thought to Consider:</b> We join this psalm of praise for our gracious and loving King. Read or sing hymn 351 v. 4.</p>	<p><b>29.</b> Rev 5:11-14 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> Despised by soldiers, he receives the praise of saints and angels. Read or sing hymn 351 v. 3.</p>	<p><b>30.</b> Jn 8:33-37 <b>Thought to Consider:</b> All on the side of truth listen to Jesus, our King victorious. Read or sing hymn 351 v. 4.</p>
