Mk 14:1-9 Thought to Consider: When we recognize the beauty and wonder of Jesus, we are moved to love him and serve him. Read or sing hymn 369 v. 2.</p>	<p>10. Psalm 93 Thought to Consider: The Lord rules over all things. His majesty and glory move us to praise him. Read or sing hymn 369 v. 3.</p>	<p>11. Psalm 144 Thought to Consider: We marvel at God's care for us and his creation. So we sing songs of praise. Read or sing hymn 369 v. 4.</p>	<p>12. Eph 1:15-23 Thought to Consider: We treasure our Savior because he has chosen us to be his dear children. Read or sing hymn 369 v. 1.</p>

Read or sing hymn 435 v. 2.</p>	<p>16. 1Pe 1:3-9 Thought to Consider: We suffer here for a little while, yet we have an inheritance waiting for us. Read or sing hymn 435 v. 2.</p>	<p>17. He 12:4-13 Thought to Consider: God disciplines and corrects us because we are his children and he wants us to grow in grace. Read or sing hymn 435 v. 1.</p>	<p>18. Php 1:27-30 Thought to Consider: In our trials and troubles we turn to the Lord in prayer. Read or sing hymn 435 v. 3.</p>	<p>19. 2Ti 2:1-10 Thought to Consider: We remain faithful to the Lord in our trials like faithful soldiers awaiting the victory our Lord has won.
